This week we had our Parent Meetings. Thanks to all of you who came in to help us learn more about your child.

Last Monday we had our monthly assembly, and we celebrated the learning our students are doing about "Social Thinking" using the "We Thinkers'" curriculum. Students from Division 8 and 9 shared the learning they are doing to help them understand that everyone has "thinking bubbles".

Shadvin from Division 9 said "Thinking bubbles are invisible. We think it in our brain." Candice from Division 9 said, "We have to share our words so they know." Keerat from Division 8 wrote this message in her writer's workshop book. These

Halloween

Students can wear their costumes to school on Halloween if they wish. All costumes must be appropriate for school. Please ensure that your child's costume does not include parts that would be frightening or gory for our young students (ie: no weapons, blood, or other gory makeup).

Costumes must also follow School District #43 guidelines:

- **Recognizable Costumes:** Students in costume should be easily recognizable and able to identify themselves to any staff member when asked. Additionally, students "in character" should behave appropriately. Intimidating, harassing, or humiliating behaviors do not contribute to a fun, festive, and safe environment.
- **Appropriate Costumes:** Replica weapons (e.g., guns, knives) are not allowed, nor are hypersexualized costumes or those depicting elements of sexual exploitation.
- **Respectful Costumes:** Costumes should not portray negative stereotypes or demean any group of people. They should not make light of anyone's religious, cultural, ethnic, or racial background.





Thanks to all of you who have already completed the tasks in your <u>SchoolCash Online</u> account. If you have not yet done so, please take care of completing the following tasks as soon as possible:

Purchase School Supplies - \$50.00

✓ Purchase a Planner – \$4.75

Planners are required for to each child in Divisions 1-7. Planners are used daily in classrooms for students to plan their week, and as a home-school communication tool.

School Policies Forms − required

These forms provide us with your consent for several school activities including using the internet and participating in neighborhood walks. We are required to collect this information every year.

Your child will not be able participate in these activities and others until these forms are complete.

☑ Emergency Release Forms – required

These provide us with the information we need should an emergency happen while your child is at school.

☑ Medical Alert – required for children with medical alert information

These forms ensure we are aware of how to respond if your child has a severe allergy or another health issue while at school.


