## Registration for the 2025-26 School Year

## Middle School

Last week a letter was sent home with each Grade 5 student with information about their catchment Middle School. If the school mentioned in the letter is the school you wish your child to attend, no further action is needed from you. If it is not, please follow the instructions in the letter, apply for cross catchment, or see the instructions below to apply for a "Program of Choice".

#### Programs of Choice

**Registration for "Programs of Choice" takes place from January 9<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am to January 15<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 PM.** Parents considering applying for a program of choice for their child for the 2025-26 school year should:

- ensure that any changes to the student data we have, especially address changes, are in our student information system. Please email <u>alderson@sd43.bc.ca</u> if any changes are needed.
- ensure you have the correct information listed as your child's "catchment" school by utilizing the school district school locator using your current address, and ensure that this is the address we have in our student information system.
- ensure that you have your child's personal education number (PEN) with you when you apply as it is required on both the Programs of Choice and the Cross Catchment applications. Your child's PEN number can be located on their report card or by accessing the MyEd parent portal.
- Parents of children with disabilities/diverse abilities needs should **register using the online registration process**. Please also contact the school to inform them of your child's needs so the school has the appropriate supports in place.


### Kindergarten Registration - February 4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>


An online registration form will be posted on the Alderson and the District websites for parents to fill out. **Please ensure that you apply at your child's catchment school** (you can check this on the <u>school locator</u>). School secretaries will be using this school locator to verify that each applicant is in our school catchment. Please be sure to read all of the information and follow the instructions regarding the required documentation for registration.

New kindergarten students who have an older sibling at Alderson are considered "in catchment" even if their address is out of our catchment area. You can apply directly to Alderson without going through the cross-catchment process. Only those students who are five years of age on or before December 31, 2025 can be accepted for September 2025 enrollment.

#### Cross Catchment Process – February 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>

If you would like your child to attend a school outside of your catchment you need to first register at the school within your catchment and then apply to be considered within our cross-catchment process. To find out about this process please click here: <u>Cross Catchment</u> **Process**.
