

Winter Weather Ahead!!

Please ensure your child is dressed for any type of weather. We go outside for recess and lunch breaks rain or shine. Occasionally (once or twice a year) we keep the students inside when the rain is extremely heavy or the situation is unsafe. Even on those days it is important that students are prepared to be outside should we ever need to evacuate the building due to an emergency situation.

2026-27 Kindergarten Registration

Please make sure to register during that week so that we can count your child during our planning and staffing process. Later registration is possible, but if you wait we cannot guarantee that we will have space for your child.


Cross Catchment Applications
