Hi Alderson Families.

We have had a wonderful first week reconnecting with our classroom communities from last year and getting to know our new students. The theme this week was friendship and learning some new playground games that everyone can play when they are outside at recess and lunch.

It is unfortunate that the skies have been a bit smoky this week and our thoughts are with the people living in areas of BC affected by the wildfires. Please know that our district is monitoring the situation and making recommendations to schools based on the current conditions. There have been times in past years when we have kept the children inside the building at recess and lunch due to the conditions and we will do the same if this year if that becomes necessary.

#### **Class Placement**

On Monday students should go to the same classroom they went to this past week. During the day they will be moved into their new classrooms. Your child's new teacher will send them home with a letter of introduction, so you know who their permanent teacher will be for the 2024-25 school year.

At the end of the day students will be dismissed from the same classroom they were dropped them off in, so you know where to find them. When you pick them up please have your child show you where their new classroom is so you know where to drop them off on Tuesday morning.

I send a newsletter out to all families each Friday. If for some reason you don't receive one, please check our website. On the home page there is a "School News" section. I always post our newsletter there as soon as it is ready on Friday. Please make sure to check it each week for new information. The newsletter often looks similar week to week but there is always some new information.

#### **Celebrating Birthdays**

At Alderson we celebrate each child's birthday by recognizing them at our monthly assemblies. In addition each classroom has their own tradition for celebrating each child's special day. We ask that parents do not send in treats for the class on birthdays—please save them for your child's home celebration. Treats brought to school make for difficult situations for

students who have dietary restrictions, and we want to make sure each of our students have a similar experience on their special day. If you have any concerns or questions about this expectation, please do not hesitate to ask.

#### School Supplies for 2025-26 School Year

We order school supplies for all children centrally, so you do not need to shop for them. By default, we are assuming that families are purchasing school supplies from us. The cost for supplies will be \$50 per child again this year. If you prefer to purchase supplies for your child on your own, please let us know.

Again this year we are utilizing special funding we received to subsidize the cost of school supplies for all students. Please understand that we will not have this funding in future years, which will affect the cost of supplies.

Currently our payment system is not ready. We let parents know when this system is ready to take your payment. If you prefer to purchase supplies on your own, supply lists are posted on our website – please follow the link below.

#### Parking: Pick-up and Drop-off

Please make sure you are aware of the parking regulations on Gauthier and Alderson Ave. Bylaw officers come by regularly to ensure that parents are following these regulations. Please also respect the following expectations:

- <u>Staff Parking is for Staff only</u> please do not use this as a place to drop off or pick up your child.
- Respect Accessible Parking The area directly in front of the school doors is to be used by people with a valid accessible parking pass. Please do not stop your car here even for a moment.
- Respect our Neighbor's Driveways Please do not block driveways or use the entrance to the complexes across the street from the school as a place to drop off your child.

In recent years we have had some concerning "near misses" with children crossing Gauthier to get to or from their parent's cars. Children should only be crossing the street accompanied by their parents. Please do not drop your child off in the middle of the street.

#### <u>Friday, Sept 19th</u> <u>Professional Development Day</u>




#### Monday, Sept 29th Truth & Reconciliation / Orange Shirt Day Assembly


