Tues, Sept. 2	<p><b>2025-26 school year begins.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Returning</u> Grade 1 to Grade 5</b> students attend school from 9:00-9:30. Please have your child return to their classroom from this past school year.</li> <li>• <b><u>New</u> Grade 1 to Grade 5</b> students attend school from 9:00-9:30. Please have your child come to the front doors of the school. They will meet some of our staff and have a tour of the school.</li> <li>• <b><u>New Kindergarten Students</u></b> attend from 9:45-10:15 in the school gym.</li> </ul>
Wed, Sept. 3-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>New and returning</u> Grade 1 to 5</b> students attend school full time. They are in temporary groupings for the first week while we finalize class placement.</li> <li>• <b><u>New Kindergarten Students</u></b> follow the gradual entry schedule which will be sent out to them in early July.</li> </ul>
Mon, Sept. 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If possible, students move into their new classrooms for the 2025-26 school year.</li> </ul>

## School Supplies for 2025-26

We are once again ordering supplies centrally as this system has been very popular with families. We expect the cost of the supplies to be about \$50.00 as they were this past year. We will have the supplies ready for our students when they arrive in September, and will also be charging parents for them at that time. In September there will be an item on KEV so that you can purchase a set of supplies for your child.

If you prefer to purchase school supplies on your own, school supply lists will be posted to the school website by July 4th, 2025. **When shopping for school supplies please keep in mind that the brands requested are important.** While you may be able to find a similar supply at a lower price, low quality materials do not last and often results in teachers requesting more supplies from you during the school year.
