Principal's Report

- What has Been Happening in our Learning Community
- Really fun day in the snow today and students were amazing
- Students really enjoyed curling – format changed with tournament day – school board rep came to visit
- Global Play Day went really well
- Playground supervisors have cards with them to help problem solve – wheel of 9 or 10 choices of what to do when you have a problem. Adult helps them choose.
- Getting ready for Student Led Conferences – hoping that students discover information with teacher guidance
- Student Teachers will be joining the Ms. Cooper and Ms. Sabourin's classrooms and there is one Student EA
- Online attendance being done by the teachers – report cards will eventually be online (not this year)

- Teachers are attending lots of workshops around the revised curriculum
