

PAC Financial Highlights 2018-2019

- Workshops and field trips for all students (up to \$14/student) – total of \$2,088:
 - Britannia Mines
 - HR MacMillan Space Centre
 - Museum of Vancouver
 - Stanley Park
- Transportation for field trips (half bus per division) – total of \$2,335:
 - Including bus to the District Track Meet
- Paid for rollerblading, curling, and hip-hop lessons for all students – \$3,720
- Paid for two school-wide ArtStarts performances/workshops – \$1,740
 - Green Thumb Theatre
 - Karima Essa (Bollywood)
- Technology – 6 projectors, TV set and cart, 6 dongles – total of \$3,500
- Classroom consumables – \$2560
 - up to \$200 per classroom for teaching supplies, plus music and student services
- Purchase of gymnastics equipment – high jump mat and a wedge for rolling – \$2,785
- New playground slide and step replacement – \$4,485
- Playground drainage improvements done (and paid for) by the district
- Total Spending \$25,800
- Fundraising:
 - Increased fundraising to fund playground – slide replacement and more to come
 - Total profit: \$23,700
 - Hot Lunch profit: \$15,200
