Health & Wellness total cost \$4600.00

4. Treasurer's report

Income last month was all hot lunch. The estimated & Budgeted are within what we thought they would be. \$20,000 difference in terms of income.

Attended the Gaming Grant talk. The gaming grant is based on the previous year's enrolment. To date, 565 students. ***Mindful cannot be used for Gift Cards.*** The criteria have changed and have become broader.

With regards to the Basketball Court would be eligible for the gaming grant. There is an additional grant - Capital Project Grant (competitive), they match the funds for larger projects, and they want you to describe how it would benefit the community, etc. Webinar in early June >

Application **June - August**, notification is not until December. \$20,000 all the way up to \$1.2M

5. Presenter - Kelly Allen - Family Smart. www.familysmart.ca

A group of parents raising kids who have challenges. Not *clinicians* - parents who have lived experiences that are there to walk with the families and give support. They will get back to any inquiries within 2 days.

The biggest thing is emotional support, providing a non-judgmental space FREE SERVICE; online, in person, email, and as often as needed. Ages 0-25. Can help provide services beyond that age, and knowledge is more limited.

Help bridge the gap while families are waiting for services. Information and resource services. Also, assist with navigation with services, as it can be overwhelming. Advocacy and coaching families.

"In The Know" online events are provided monthly. I.e. Emotion Regulation, ADHD, anxiety ... A group of 30 parents who watch the video, and there is a facilitated conversation after that. There is a video library for anyone to look at as they need (up to 40 videos that also have cc).

Offer workshops developed by other peer support groups and other parents, more complex subjects.

Question (Renee:) How do parents learn about this? Farmers Markets, Schools, Administrators.
