 - a. Loving his time here for our first month. Connection is near and dear to my heart so doing our best to learn all the new names. Getting the kids involved with announcements etc. Adjusting to our smaller school and kids being more spread out during recess. a. Hot Lunch -

- ii. 69 orders so far for the first trimester, profit of over 500
- iii. Keeping pricing competitive but many prices did go up a small amount
- iv. Treat days can always be added in at any time so let Crystal know if you have any ideas

b. Fundraising -

- i. Dominos Pizza Night: \$80 raised
- ii. Excel Dec 6 made over 1000 last year, let's promote!
- iii. Poco Sweet shop could be an option this year on top of purdys. No minimum. We will be booking soon. Could be purchased through munch-a-lunch
- iv. Challenging to find new options that do not have huge minimums for our small school
- v. Pies is an 800 minimum with a small payback
- vi. TCBY planning is underway, order through munch-a-lunch or purchase a supply and sell any extras. TCBY freezer would be ideal rather than distributing orders. Previously we have had a freezer of TCBY at sports day, could be booked any day as a treat day.
- vii. Photo expressions in nov-dec has some packages with funds raised
- viii. Parent Idea: Book sale, people donate books and resold for \$1 each to raise funds. Feedback from previous year, be prepared to manage leftover books that are unsold. Man-power and space to organize will need to be planned, possibly during a

- school dance. The mom is very passionate about the idea and would be willing to assist with organizing and donating leftovers at the end of the sale.
- ix. Fruit/Veggie sale update will be soon and we will book ASAP when we get approval for the program
- x. Open to any and all ideas you have, food and snack sales have been the most popular options in the online poll. Looking into more snack sales and will collaborate with Karen when she is back from her trip.
- xi. Popcorn sale is always a hit and a low cost option
- xii. Momentum looking to be booked in the spring
- xiii. Dennis will be looking into the bottle drive option for PAC or if it will be for the school account only
- c. Pumpkin Patch PAC has been bringing in the pumpkin patch to Birchland school for the past few years with a petting zoo for the kids to enjoy. Had been \$4/pumpkin/kid previously, ~\$540. Looking at funds to make sure it is able to be done this year. Petting zoo was \$870. Wondering if it would be plausible to charge a small fee or asking donations from students to help fund the experience? School cash online could possibly be used to help keep anonymity of donations. Looking at specific fundraisers to help support cost as well.
