We want to continue to work with the core competencies, through <i>The Six Cedar Trees</i>, to build on last year's goal. In our 2018-2019 APL, we focused on each competency area through a monthly 30 Days of Learning approach. This year we aim to dive deeper into each of the core competency areas to deepen understanding and application of the competency areas. With a growing focus on student reflection and self-assessment, a solid understanding of the language of the core competencies is critical. Students can only reflect on the competency areas if they truly understand them and have opportunities to apply the skills learned.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How will we involve students? • How will we monitor progress and adjust actions? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ September 2019 Staff Retreat: staff will continue to refine the APL goal and the action plan for each of the 5 focus areas. ➤ Staff meetings: lesson sharing and collaboration time to build understanding, deepen practice, monitor progress, and adjust actions if necessary. ➤ 30 Day of Learning: Each month the Pro-d team will work to develop a targeted 30 days of learning focus. The whole staff will prioritize this focus into 8 months. Activities will be designed to build common understanding of the competency areas and will nurture connection. ➤ Pro-D Team and School Connections Committee ➤ Collaborative time for staff/ Whole School Gathering for Students ➤ Staff-based Learning Teams (TBD) ➤ Staff Room “The Six Cedar Trees” mural reflects ongoing work.
