 - Gerald Shong (Assistant Superintendent)-discussed process for school registration, cross catchment and programs of choice
 - Stephanie Maki (District Principal of Indigenous Education)-presented on the Indigenous Advisory Committee which represents diversity of Indigenous peoples residing in the district; the committee meets a minimum of 4 times per year and reports to the Superintendent
 - Rosey Manhas (DPAC President)-represents SD43 and presents to the school board about key issues; 4 key issues presented at the last meeting-climate control in classrooms, extra staff/noon hour supervisors, washroom safety and privacy in middle/high school, safe space for e-bikes and scooters
 - Nadine Tambellini (Assistant Superintendent)-addressed concerns over the reporting structure of the Proficiency Scale and will likely present again at the next DPAC meeting
