Dear Parents:

We have been pleased with how well our adjustment to our new COVID-19 protocols has gone. Students have become very adept at washing hands, ensuring they are maintaining distance with those outside of their learning groups, and being respectful of all the procedures that make school a little different this year. Thank you for adapting to this new reality and the changes in procedure.

A few reminders:

- Please do not enter the school building unless you have made an appointment ahead of time. If you have a scheduled meeting, please wait outside the front entrance for the staff member with whom you are meeting or call the school office to let us know you have arrived. Any visitor, including parents and caregivers, with a scheduled appointment must wear a mask while inside the building, and sanitize hands upon arrival.
- Please remember when you are dropping students off to ensure you and your child(ren) are maintaining physical distance from families in other classes. Please take you child(ren) directly home rather than remaining on school grounds or the playground area.
- If your child has forgotten their lunch, please leave it outside the front door on the shelf designated for student pick up/ drop off. At this time fast food lunches (such as McDonalds) are not permitted.
- It is parents' responsibility to ensure you are assessing your child(ren) using the symptoms listed on the Daily Health Check, which is available on the school website (and attached to this message as well, as a reminder). Please take the time to review your child(ren)'s health each day before sending your student(s) to school.
- There are number of parents/caregivers who have yet to sign off acknowledgement of the Daily Health Check requirements. That form is available on School Cash Online, (<u>https://sd43.schoolcashonline.com/</u>) and **must** be completed for your child to continue to attend school. Dress for the Weather

Our students will be expected to go out for fresh air at recess and lunch, even when it is raining. As we enter the winter season, *please ensure that your child comes to school prepared for the weather conditions.*

In the event of heavy snow, ice or extreme temperatures, a decision on school closures will take place as soon as possible after 6:00 a.m. that day.

- Be sure to hit Refresh when checking back
- The district website posting is official *there is no need to call the school or the Board office after viewing*
- Tune in to CKWX 1130 AM, CKNW 980 AM or CBC 690 AM for updates

If there is no school closure announced, we respect that parents may still decide to keep their child home due to inclement weather. In this case, we request that you inform the school of the absence as per our usual routine.

Winter Weather Ahead!

Schools are not routinely closed due to snow or other inclement weather conditions. All schools in School District 43 (Coquitlam) will remain OPEN, if possible, during winter weather, including snowfall.

However, on occasion, a district-wide or partial-district closure is required due to extreme weather. Partial-district closures affecting individual schools may occur due to the very different geography within our school district. If there is a partial-district closure affected schools will be identified. The decision on schools remaining open or needing to be closed, because of extreme weather, occurs **before 6:30 a.m.** so that families can plan and make alternate arrangements.

Any district-wide or partial-district closure will be decided and communicated by 6:30 a.m. via the School District 43 website www.sd43.bc.ca and CKNW AM 980 radio, CKWX 1130 radio and CBC (690) radio.

Extreme weather can also impact transit. Transit schedules may face significant changes or cancellations due to the weather conditions. Parents seeking information on transit schedules need to consult the Translink website: <u>http://www.translink.ca/</u>
