## Happy New Year and Welcome Back!

It is truly energizing to see our learners engaging in their learning and showing curiosity, positivity, excitement, and laughter as they learn. Thank you for the gratitude regularly shown for our teachers and educational assistants as they lead our learners in finding interesting and creative approaches to talking and showing what they know and can do.

As we begin the New Year, we want to thank families for your continued commitment to following the COVID-19 Safety Protocols. The province-wide health orders remain in place, specifically at this time families are not allowed to have play dates, birthday parties or sleep overs with anyone outside of their immediate household.

- Please ensure that you complete the Daily Health Check before determining if your child should be sent to school. A copy is attached to this newsletter to review and refresh your memory on the requirements for daily checking your children for any symptoms of COVID-19. When in doubt, it is best to have your student remain at home until they are symptom free and/or have received a negative test.
- Students are to remain in their own learning cohort or class.
- When dropping off and picking up students, ensure that you maintain a minimum of six-feet from students and families outside your learning group. Wear a mask if possible while on school grounds.
- Parents and adults may not enter the building without an appointment. Please contact the school if you need to meet with a staff member and wait outside the building until you are directed to enter by a staff member. All visiting adults must wear a mask once invited into the building.
- Please remind your children of the importance of hand washing and of not touching others, sharing food, personal equipment (pens, pencils, etc). January and February are traditionally peak season for cold and flu viruses. Obviously, this year we need to be most vigilant about our practices to ensure student, staff, and family safety.

#### <u>Kindergarten Registration - January 27 - February 4, 2021</u>

Kindergarten registration for September 2021 will be held throughout the district on the above dates. Registration will only be available *online* using the online form on your catchment school's website during the registration period. In order to be eligible for kindergarten a child must be 5 years of age by December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Parents must provide their child's **Birth Certificate** and proof of Canadian Citizenship for parent **and** child (i.e.PR Card, Passport) and proof of residency in B.C. (e.g. rental contract, property purchase agreement, tax notice, utility bill, etc.). You can find the full checklist and more information here:

All Kindergarten students must register at their catchment school, **before** completing a Cross Catchment Application, **except** those students with siblings at the requested school who will be attending the following year. Please note that siblings of students who will be in attendance at a school are considered as a catchment area child at that school if the sibling is remaining at the school the following year. #### **Cross Catchment Process**

Cross catchment requests must be completed online. Cross catchment applications will be accepted starting at 9 am on Friday, February 5<sup>th</sup> and close at 4:00 pm on Wednesday, February 10<sup>th</sup>.
