FINANCIAL STATE

BPAC raised **\$9,400** from ongoing events like Hot Lunches, Treat Days, and the milk program; and **\$6,200** from other fundraisers like Coupon Books, Created by Kids, Neufeld's, and Purdy's for a total of **\$15,600**.

The funds raised went towards:

- Ultimate Frisbee - \$3,600
- Grade 5 Leaving - \$3,000
- Classroom Fund* - \$2,475
- Student Planners - \$2,050
- Sports Day Carnival - \$1,000
- Pancake Breakfast - \$1,000
- Dance Party - \$760
- 2 Wireless Microphones - \$750
- Staff Appreciation - \$360
- Munchalunch Fees - \$360
- Kindergarten Parent Tea - \$75

Total Program Expenses - **\$15,430**

*Note: Each division receives \$225 for school supplies towards in class projects and activities

GAMING GRANT

Every school year, PACs receive a grant of \$20 per student from the BC Government that can be used for specific expenditures. For 24-25, BPAC received \$4,920. Traditionally, BPAC uses the grant to fund up to \$400 per division for field trips and in class science and learning experiences. Some of the 24-25 field trips and experiences included skating, swimming, Grouse mountain, Science World, baby chick egg hatching, and butterfly larvae! BPAC used the remaining funds and some leftover from previous years for the Ache Brasil and Metaphor school-wide performances.
