#### Principal's Update

- Construction: work in progress and mostly on-time; the gym roof is mostly completed; glass and seals have been fully replaced in the library roof; currently they are working on resealing classrooms with outside doors, students go to a vacant classroom for the day while this work in being completed
- Successful school Halloween festivities: students enjoyed the "glow room" and seeing all
  their art on the walls; thank you to teachers and staff who put this experience together
  for the students
- Successful Remembrance Day school assembly
- Volleyball is currently wrapping up and in January the Basketball season will start
- Winter Concert will be held Wednesday December 17th: 2 shows (one right after recess and the other right after lunch), we are going to utilize the school stage for the performance, use KEV for parents to reserve 2tix/student for either the first or second show (try to accommodate everyone and more tickets may be made available to families depending on the reservation numbers and circumstances)
- Mural: currently in the early planning stages, looking to have a mural painted in the gym
  with the intention to instill school pride and sense of community; reached out to 2 artists,
  potentially start the work during spring break, design to be determined
  (landscape/nature/animal:bears); potential for PAC to support this with PAC funding
- Black Top Games: when the weather is better seeking to have some new games painted on the school blacktop, some schools may loan us their stencils; potential for PAC to support this with PAC funding
- Drop Off/Plck Up: further monitoring for the drop off area in front of the school and additional messaging to parents about proper driving etiquette during drop-off/pick-up (reduce speed, appropriate use of drop off areas)

### Treasurer's Report

- Overall in a good and healthy financial position
- \$32k in the general account
  - -Total expenses paid was \$2700 which include payments for the milk / hot lunch
- \$7732 in the gaming account / no expenses paid through this account
- \$19k term fund usage ideas?
- PAC is funding 3 school activities (2 performances and Gym Sense) totalling \$5550

# Past Fundraisers and Event Updates

- Neufeld: success, profit of \$555; orders will be available for pick up Nov.19th at 730pm
- Sun-Oka Apple: 40 boxes sold; raised \$450; orders will be available for pick up Nov.21st after school
- Grade 5 Hoodies: 40 orders (out of 46 students), hoodies will be dropped off to the school Nov.21st to then be handed out to students
- Fruits and Veggies: going great; chance to win \$500 from the program if the school is selected by submitting photos of the students with their fruits/veggies \*\*only the students who have a signed consent form will have their photos taken\*\*

# Ongoing Event Updates

- Milk: issues regarding students registered names vs preferred names have now been rectified; new volunteer coordinator taking over the role, Candace
- Hot Lunch: very successful, lots of parent volunteers, vendors are confirmed for the second half of the year
- Treat Days: very successful, Dec.12th will be the last one before winter break; the profit on the first treat day was \$238 and for the second one it was \$217
- Purdys: currently running, closes on Nov.21st, so far there has been \$576 in sales; flyer will be posted to FB to advertise the fundraiser to the Bramblewood community
- Munch-a-Lunch Coordinator: new volunteer coordinators taking over this role, Shaillize (?Jessica)
