#### Kindergarten Registration - Online (February 6 - 8, 2024)



- Date of Online Kindergarten Reg.: Tues. Feb 6-Thur. Feb 8, 2024
- When can my child start Kindergarten: Children who are 5 years old on or before Dec 31, 2024 may enter school in September 2024. You may defer your child's enrolment until September 2024.
- When Should I Register My Child? Kindergarten registration (except for Programs of Choice Montessori, Mandarin Bilingual, Reggio and French Immersion) within School District No. 43 (Coquitlam) will be held between Friday, Feb 9, 2024 @ 9 am to Wednesday, Feb 14·2024 @ 4 pm using the online forms on your catchment school's website.
- Use School Locator to determine your catchment school

All Kindergarten students must register at their catchment school, **before** completing a Cross Catchment Application, **except** those students with siblings at the requested school who will be attending the following year. Please note that siblings of students who will be in attendance at a school are considered as a catchment area child at that school if the sibling is remaining at the school the following year. If your child is new to Bramblewood and you have not received your username and password to the MyEd portal, kindly check your junk mail first to look for a message from Myed directly. IMPORTANT: We request that all families ensure they have portal access prior to March 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid unnecessary delay in accessing your child's/children's report cards. All families are again reminded to print off their child(ren)s report card for their personal files.

#### Student Learning Survey 2024

To the **Parents of Grade 4 students**, you are reminded of the **Student Learning Survey**. The Student Learning Survey has been administered annually in BC public schools since 2001. It is the only source of province-wide information on in-school process and the learning environment. In addition to providing planning data for districts and schools, the survey has been used by the Representative for Children and Youth to report on the wellbeing of youth in BC, by the Ministry of Health to support healthy school initiatives and by other organizations. The survey takes about 15 to 20 minutes to complete. This is an opportunity for feedback online. Parents of students in Grade 4 are invited to participate voluntarily. Please note that the survey is available in approximately 16 languages. This survey will be available for your **completion until February 29**, **2024**. We appreciate your valuable feedback.

#### Student Safety & Supervision



The district wide expectation is that at dismissal time students will be picked up by their caregivers. Students who are walking home need to do so right after the dismissal bell. **Please keep in mind that supervision ends at 2:45pm.** Students who are still waiting for a caregiver will at that time be brought to the office by their classroom teacher. The office will help them to contact their parent or caregiver.

Once children are in the care of their parent/caregiver, should you frequent the playground with your child(ren), parents are responsible for their care. Older children who want to frequent the playground must go home and return with parent permission to be unsupervised. Thank you for cooperating with this system, as it is designed to make sure that students stay safe.

Thank you to those drivers who have been following the drive through regulations and obeying the signage on Bramble Lane. A reminder that the drive through is just that — a drive through. **Drivers need to always remain in their cars**. Emergency vehicles need to be able to access the drive through at all times. **DO NOT PARK IN THE STAFF LOT**. If you want to meet your child(ren) at their classroom door, please park on the street or in the tennis court parking lot.

#### Winter Weather

Schools are not routinely closed due to snow or other inclement weather conditions. All schools in School District 43 (Coquitlam) will remain OPEN, if possible, during winter weather, including snowfall.



However, on occasion, a district-wide or partial-district closure is required due to extreme weather. Partial-district closures affecting individual schools may occur due to the very different geography within our school district. If there is a partial-district closure affected schools will be identified.

The decision on schools remaining open or needing to be closed, because of extreme weather, occurs **before 6:30 a.m**. so that families can plan and make alternate arrangements.

Any district-wide or partial-district closure will be decided and communicated by 6:30 a.m. via the School District 43 website www.sd43.bc.ca and CKNW AM 980 radio, CKWX 1130 radio and CBC (690) radio.

Extreme weather can also impact transit. Transit schedules may face significant changes or cancellations due to the weather conditions. Parents seeking information on transit schedules need to consult the Translink website: <a href="http://www.translink.ca/">http://www.translink.ca/</a>
