

Hello Castle Park Families of current Kindergarten to Grade 4 students,

We are sharing information about school supplies for the **2026-2027** school year. We are providing lists with a purchase option for Grade 2-5 students.

For next year's Kindergarten and Grade 1 students we are doing a school organized bulk order which will be paid through [www.schoolcashionline.ca](http://www.schoolcashionline.ca). For these bulk orders we will collect a supply package fee of \$65 from our future Grade 1 students. Parents of **current Kindergarten students** will receive an email notification from School Cash Online when the item is live. Next year's kindergarten students will pay for bulk supplies in **September**.

**For next year's Grades 2-5 students** the **School Start Packs** Supply Ordering process for next school year (2026-2027) is now up and running. The School Supply Packs will be available to purchase "ONLINE only" – please click on the link below to place your order. If you choose not to order your child's school supplies through School Start, attached you will find the Grades 2-5 School Supply Lists for shopping on your own. Part of the reason we use these packs is for consistency in the quality of supplies and to give parents options to have all their school supplies taken care of for them. Going out and buying from various vendors takes you time and effort while generally not saving much money.

The deadline for ordering Grade 2-5 packs for delivery to school before summer break is **Wednesday, June 17th**. These are scheduled to be delivered to our school in the last week of June and will be sent home with your child(ren) before they leave for the summer break.

You may still order supplies after this deadline; however these will be shipped to your home with a shipping cost of \$7.50.
