
Happy January! We hope you enjoy the second edition of the *Cedar Reader*. We spent lots of time researching, typing, and editing the stories in this edition.

Jarred Genaille, is Cree, Salteaux and Anishnabe with his ancestral roots originating from Misipawistik Cree Nation, Lake St. Martin, First Nation and Cowessess First Nation. He first started hoop dancing when he was 9 years old. Hoop Dancing is an Indigenous practice and a form of storytelling through dance. While dancing, Jarred used many hoops to make animal shapes around his body with the hoops. He made an eagle, butterfly, horse, flower and many others. Hoop Dancing is a challenging activity. Jarred keeps his body and mind healthy by going to the gym 5 days a week, drinking lots of water and spending time hiking in nature.



Tiny: 4 students


Would you rather go to Rocky Point Park or McDonalds?




