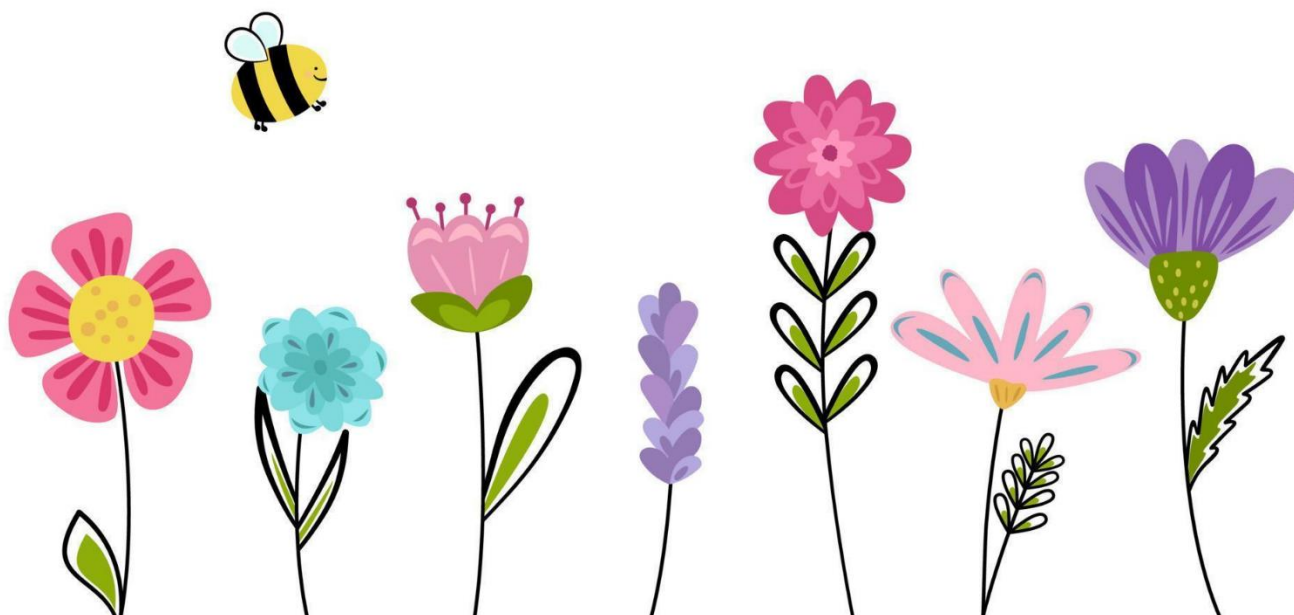

## 2025-2026 Class Placement - Parent Input

We will soon begin the process of planning our classes for next year. The placement of students will be determined through school-based professional conversations and decisions involving all relevant staff, including classroom and learning support teachers, the school counsellor and the school principal.

Classes will be organized to include students who learn in a variety of ways. As much as possible, we attempt to maintain balanced classes with mixed-ability groupings. There is often the misconception that students with strong academic skills are placed as the younger students in a combined class; this is not the case. Each child is considered individually, and students are given the most appropriate placement possible based on the information available. Any number of factors are thoughtfully considered when placing a student including:

- Students' intellectual, social and emotional development
- Positive social groups and optimal learning environments
- School-based learning support team recommendations
- Inclusion of students with diverse abilities, English language learners and medical accommodations
- Adhering to ministry class size limits and class composition requirements

Parents are welcome to provide the school with important information that may assist in the placement of their child. Information such as instructional methods that will best support your child, possible personality conflicts or significant educational concerns are helpful. Please do not make specific teacher or friend requests but let us know the type of learning environment that will best meet your child's needs. Parental input will be considered but it is not a guarantee for class placement.

*Please note that we don't carry over requests from previous years. If you requested something in the past and feel it still applies to your child, please resubmit another form.*
