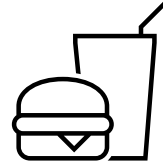

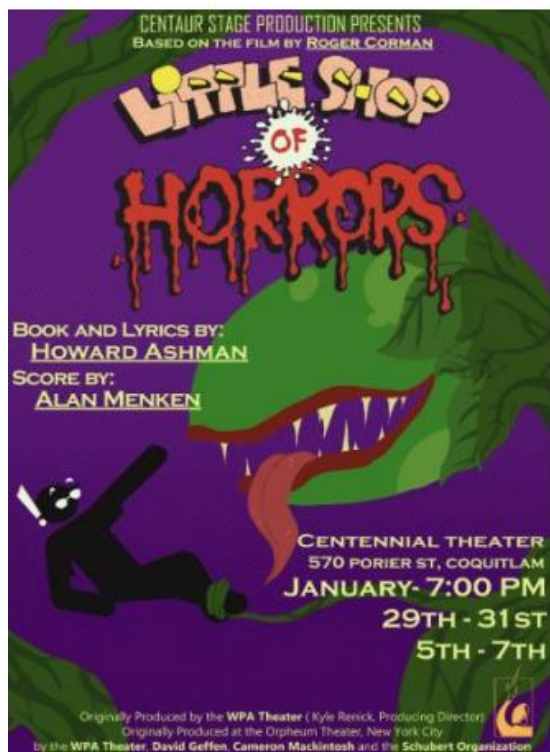

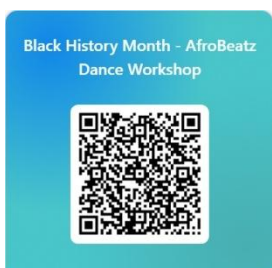

- Must be ineligible for the BC Tuition Waiver Program (for former youth in care)
- Must use funding for a post-secondary institution or college

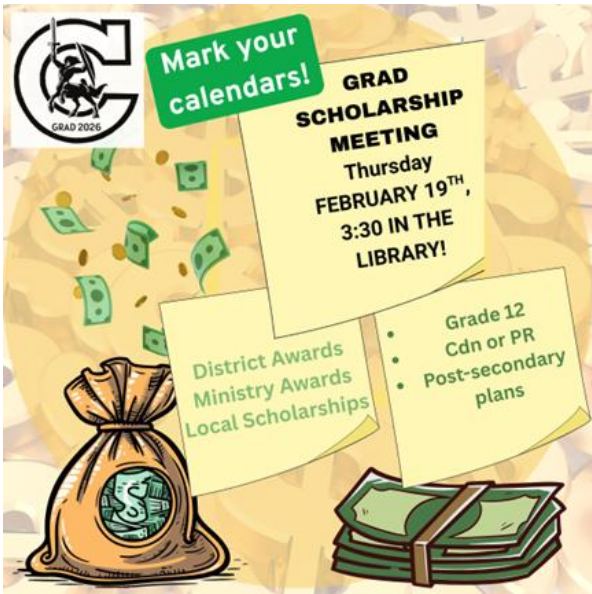
- Must be endorsed by their school principal (*see info about the nomination/ endorsement process below)
