

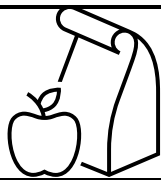

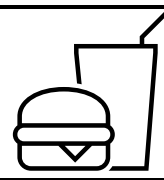

CENTENNIAL CROSS COUNTRY



The Centennial Cross Country Team had a tremendous showing at the B.C. Cross Country Championships in Nanaimo this past weekend. To begin, the conditions were incredibly challenging with a torrential downpour on Saturday. The course was completely bogged down with mud. In attendance were representatives from over 1900 high schools from all over the province. Each division had approximately 300 competitors. All our athletes had to fight their way through a crowd of 300 runners over a distance of 5 kilometers in ankle deep mud!

Our only Junior Boy and individual runner to compete this year was Gabriel Smegelski. He ran the course in a time of 18:03 and finished 189th in a group of 300 runners and represented Centennial wonderfully.

We also had a team represent Centennial this year, our Senior Girls. They ran the last race of the day after six groups of 300 had already destroyed the course through a day of pelting rain and churning up the ground into “soupy” mud. They were undeterred, however, as they managed to finish in sixth place in the entire province.

Taysia Lennstrom continued her dominance in the province in this event finishing sixth overall in the entire field with a time of 19:13. To be clear, there were only five girls in the entire province of British Columbia that finished in front of her. It should be noted that Taysia is a grade 10 student, while all five girls ahead of her were Senior Girls. As well, the 5th place girl was in front of Taysia and over the line by inches, and the 4th placed girl was only 2 seconds in front of her.

Other amazing feats of athleticism were performed by team members Kallee Lennstrom [21:46], Keira Ballantyne [23:35], Lainey Stutters [25:03] and Violet Drazenovic [27:15]. All five members of the Centennial Cross Country Team had a collective score that placed them in sixth place in the province.

Our prospects for next year look good as only Lainey Stutters is in grade 12 and therefore graduating. Two members are only in grade 10 [Taysia Lennstrom and Violet Drazenovic] and therefore we have them to represent us for another two years at the senior level.

Congratulations ladies on a performance that has not been matched at Centennial since 1982, which is a period of 43 years!
