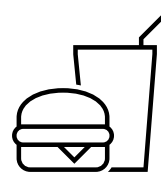

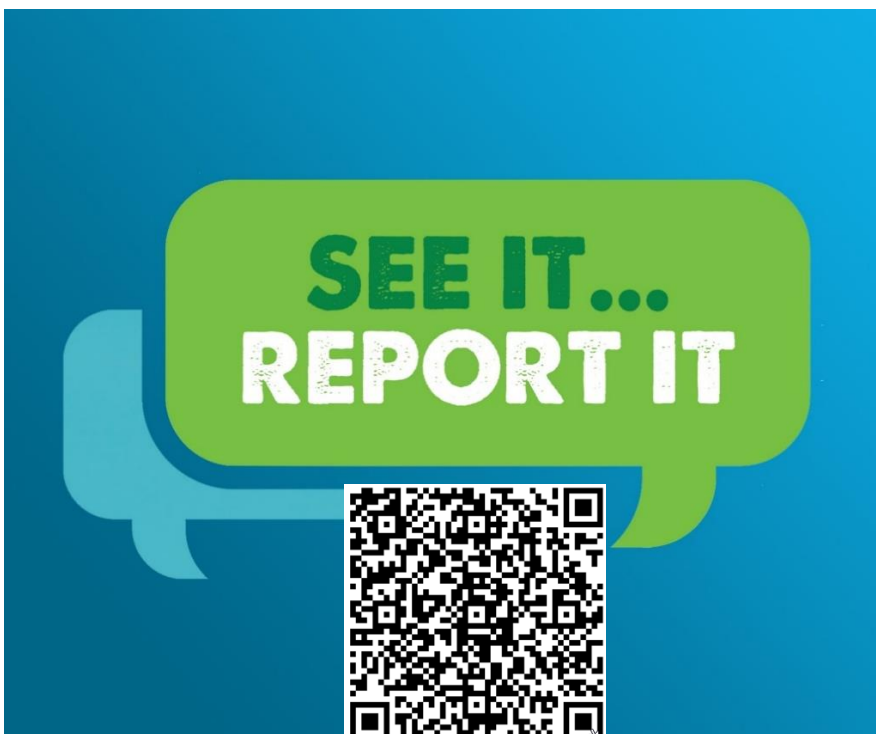

The Q&A (Queers and Allies) Club

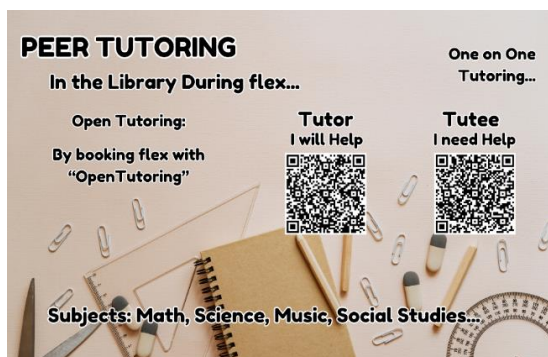

What the "L" - 2 day Training for the ICBC Learners Permit Test.

New this year:

- Applications are now open to all SD43 students aged 16 and older.
- **Cost:** \$20. This includes breakfast, lunch, transportation to the ICBC testing center, and the fee for the Learner's Permit Knowledge test.

Program Details:

The Coquitlam School District is offering students the opportunity to participate in a 2-day instructional program with an ICBC instructor to help them prepare for the Learner's Permit test. On the second day of the program, students will take the Learner's Permit test, with the goal of successfully completing it. This program is designed for students who may face barriers in obtaining their learner's permit, including but not limited to: test anxiety, learning challenges, financial need, limited access to resources or vehicles, and others.

- **Dates:** May 6th and May 13th **Time:** 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM
- **Location:** Winslow Center **Other:** Breakfast and lunch provided **Cost:** \$20.00
