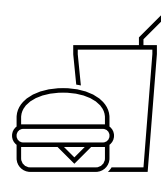

Black Art Showcase: Black History Month Club

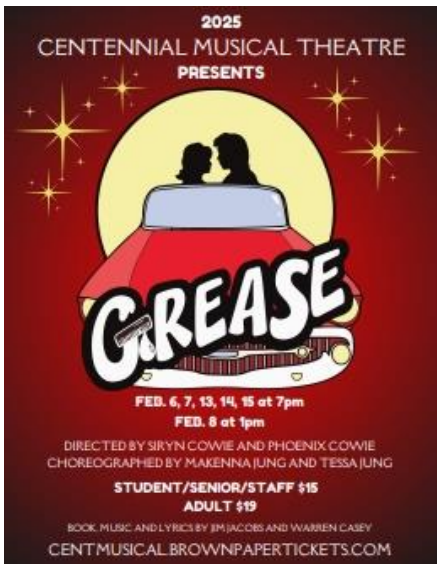
