*This is a general job posting for all Fair positions across all departments at the PNE (ex. Rides, Guest Services, Food &

Beverage, and more!). In order to work at the Fair at the PNE, **you must be at least 15 years of age or older by August 1 2018.** You must also be available to work up to full time hours (40 hours (week) during the Eair period from August 18th to September 3rd

be available to work up to full-time hours (40 hours/week) during the Fair period from August 18th to September 3rd, including day, evening and weekend shifts; as well as the two weeks prior to the start of Fair for orientation, training and any required departmental Fair set-up.

Agriculture:

- Assist in running the Entertainment Production Office
- Must have a valid BC Class 5 Driver's License, and completion of Grade 12 preferred

Fair Ambassadors:

- To patrol designated area of building or grounds
- Provide exceptional and friendly guest service

Fair Ambassadors (GRAVEYARD):

- To patrol designated area of building or grounds
- Provide exceptional and friendly guest service
- Must be available to work 11pm to 7am

Fair Box Office Attendant:

- Scan and verify guest tickets for the Summer Night Concert Series
- Provide exceptional and friendly guest service

Finance:

- Verify, record and balance all incoming monetary and cash disbursements
- Reconcile and balance inventory
- Must have successful completion of Grade 12
- Candidates must undergo a Criminal Record Check

F&B Vendor:

- Encourage the sale of food items to guests
- Must be able to accurately balance cash to the amount of product sold

Grill Cook:

- Cook a variety of foods for various fast paced concession stands and restaurants
- Must have knowledge of the rules and regulations regarding the safe handling of food items
- Must have related experience in restaurant or grill operations

Games Attendant:

- Interact with guests and encourage them to play, monitor play and enforce rules
- Maintain accurate inventory of Games merchandise
- Excellent cash handling skills

- Greet guests entering the Admission Gates during the PNE's annual Fair

- Must be 19 years of age by August 1 2018
- Must be very vocal and have an outgoing personality
- Candidates must undergo a Criminal Record Check

Casino Wheels Dealer:

- Operate Wheel of Fortune Games within rules and regulations
- Must be 19 years of age by August 1 2018
- Interact with guests and encourage them to play

Parker:

- To direct vehicles to the appropriate parking spaces as quickly, efficiently and safely as possible
- Provide exceptional and friendly guest service

Prize Home Host:

- Meet and greet guests in a courteous and professional manner
- Learn a script and inform guests visiting the PNE Prize Home of its features, sponsors and prizing

Rides Attendant:

- Operate all rides and attractions in a safe manner
