Horatio Alger Vocational & Technical Education Scholarships 25 \$3,000 Scholarships funded through the generosity of the Members of the Horatio Alger Association of Canada

To be eligible for the Horatio Alger Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship Program, an applicant must:

- Have completed high school (or earned high school equivalency credential) by July 1
- Be enrolled in a 3 years or less career or technical degree/certificate program at a not-for-profit institution in Fall 2024 that will lead to employment
- Demonstrated critical financial need (\$65,000 or less annual net income per family is required)
- Demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be under the age of 35
- Be a Canadian citizen

Apply from March 15 until June 15.
