**Trades & Arts Scholarship (2 x \$1500)** – these scholarships will be awarded to students in SD43 pursuing a career in Trades or a career in Visual Arts or Fine & Performing Arts. Criteria: Secondary school coursework in the areas of **Trades or Fine & Performing Arts**. One page paper outlining why the

applicant wants to pursue a career in Trades, Visual Arts or Fine & Performing Arts. Applicants are encouraged to include any information demonstrating financial need.

**Equity Scholarship (4 x \$1500)** – these scholarships will be awarded to students who identify as **Indigenous, Black, a person of colour, LGBTQ2S+, or a person with a disability.**

Criteria: one page paper outlining what their chosen field is and why the applicant has chosen to pursue a career in that field. Applicants are encouraged to include any information demonstrating financial need.

### **Horatio Alger Vocational & Technical Education Scholarships 25 \$3,000 Scholarships funded through the generosity of the Members of the Horatio Alger Association of Canada**

To be eligible for the Horatio Alger Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship Program, an applicant must:

- Have completed high school (or earned high school equivalency credential) by July 1
- Be enrolled in a 3 years or less career or technical degree/certificate program at a not-for-profit institution in Fall 2024 that will lead to employment
- Demonstrated critical financial need (\$65,000 or less annual net income per family is required)
- Demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be under the age of 35
- Be a Canadian citizen

Apply from March 15 until June 15.

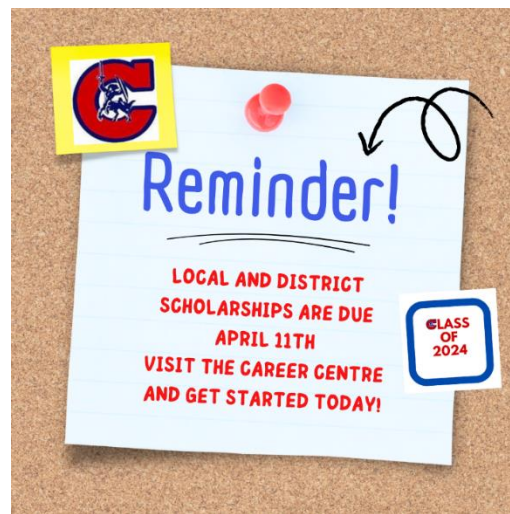
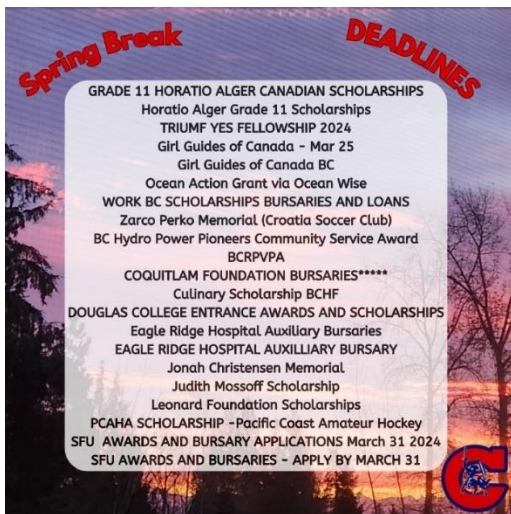
