

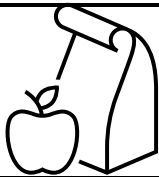


CENTENNIAL TODAY

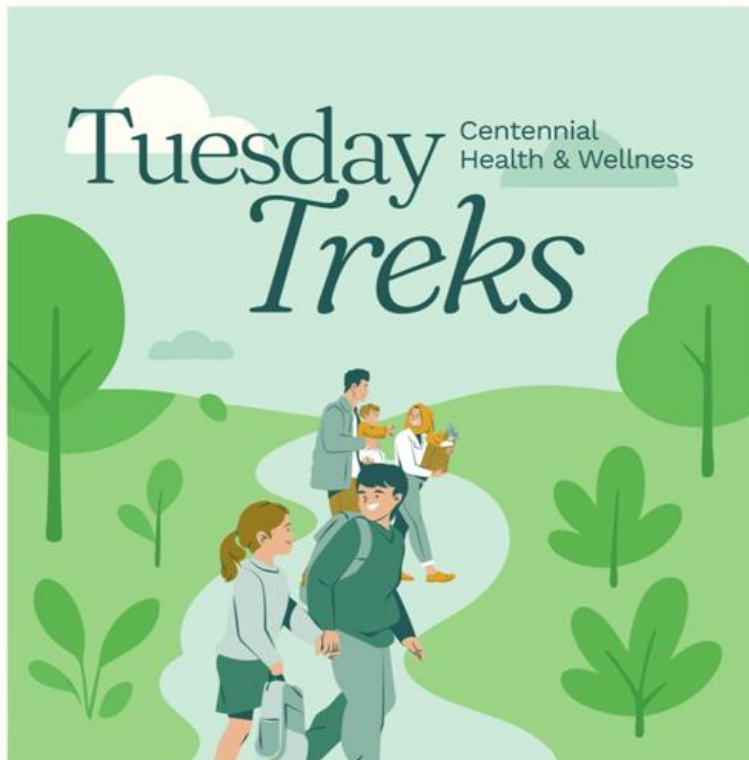
