

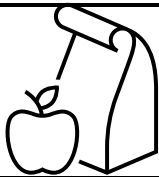


# CENTENNIAL TODAY

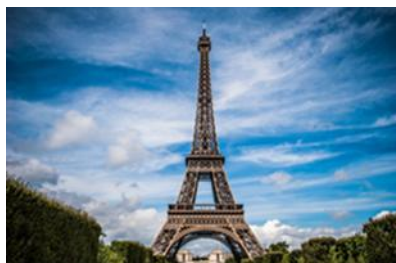
