

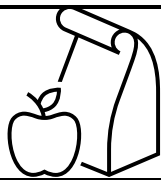

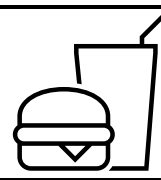
Monday, October 27, 2025 - Day 1
