

CENTENNIAL FASHION SHOW



Swimmers Provincial Relay

Thank you to EVERYONE who covered for me and to all of you who are working extra with these athletes to help them catch up.

Our Boys team were AMAZING - they placed 3rd in the province, behind St Georges and Penticton, both of which have full time coaches, their own pool and all year swimming programs!

Our Girls came top 20 in a tough field with a team of only 7 (two with no previous racing experience!) so very well done

HIGHLIGHTS: Davin Rollins won gold in 50m Breaststroke and bronze in the 100m IM Derex Yang won gold in the 200 m IM (very exciting come from behind finish!) as well as a 7th in 100 m breaststroke. Our boys Medley relay won silver (Andrew Matheson, Davin, Eden Yeung and Alex Cornescu) and our Boys 200 m Free relay won bronze (Timothy Ngai, Andrew, Davin and Alex).

We had a girls 4 x 100m free relay that was 7th fastest - Oliviak Kubiscek, Kennedy Kwan, Meghan Lubog and Maya Paul stepped in to cover for Hailey Jeong when she couldn't make the final.

Other individual top results include Alex C was 4^{th} in 100m free, Taysia Langstrom was 7^{th} in 100 m free and 10^{th} in 50m free, Josh Kim was 6^{th} in 100m free and 9^{th} in 100 m breaststroke, Andrew M was 6^{th} in the 50 m backstroke and 5^{th} in the 100 m IM.

ALL our other relays made finals and earned points (including great swims from the rest of our Provincial qualifiers: Yana Khrissanova, Kaegan Guilty, Jacob Matheson, Owen Yeung, Arsham Dehghani, Rikuto Nobuhara, Manisha Dunenkepotha).
