



PROGRAM SPOTLIGHTs - UBC Bachelor of Pharmaceutical Sciences Degree | Pharmsci Does this program lead to a Pharmacy qualification? No, the BPSc is an undergraduate science degree. Graduates of the BPSc program will not be eligible to become pharmacists without completing an Entry-to-Practice PharmD degree program.

Student cohort of 80 - Four years of full-time study - One of two programs in Canada The Bachelor of Pharmaceutical Sciences, offered by the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, focuses on discovery and development of drugs and therapies, formulations, nutraceuticals and supplements, and personal care products.

The Entry-to-Practice Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) Program | Pharmsci

Is NOT open to high schools students. TWO YEARS of study with required prerequisites (science/math) is required for admission consideration. Students will study 4 additional years to be eligible to become a pharmacist. (Faculty of Science) Tuition - Approx. 20K per year.


