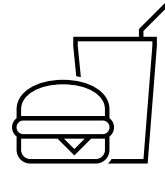

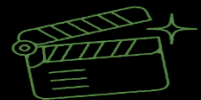
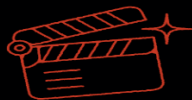
WHAT IS JUNETHEENTH?

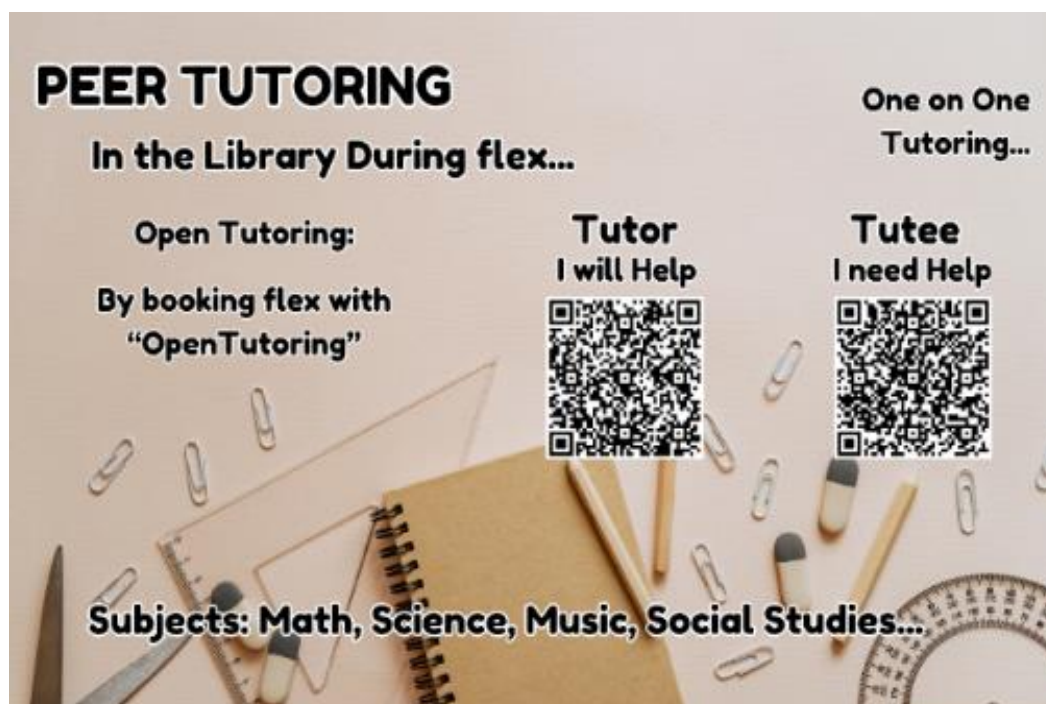
