

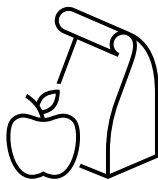

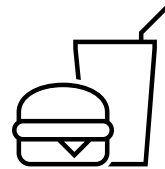
Thursday, June 5, 2025 – Day 1
