Reflection

Although Action Plans for Learning are not new, there has been substantive change in the process of creating and revisiting our work on school goals. Having the opportunity to connect with other schools with similar goals was valuable in hearing about the creative and important work occurring in other learning communities. Central staff also engaged in ongoing dialogue about our work in literacy, self-regulation and indigenous ways of learning.

Based on the work of our literacy committee, Central will be purchasing whole class readers and levelled readers. These new resources will become part of a school wide plan that seeks to more intentionally guide our instruction of reading. There is currently much debate about whole language vs phonetic approaches to reading instruction and Central will adopt a balanced program knowing that no single approach benefits all learners. Whole school focused initiatives and class based programs will continue in our work on self-regulation, but we hope to continue and deepen our engagement with students in terms of what they identify as being helpful strategies. The self-regulation squad was useful in amplifying student voices and ideas. Orange Shirt Day and Indigenous Peoples Day were two important events in our community and served as visible ways of recognizing and celebrating this aspect of the Central community. We plan to begin the 2022 school year using circles of courage as a means of establishing connectivity and respect within our community. We also have plans to create an indigenous focused room that will display artwork and artifacts, providing a place to come together. The creation of a circle of rock benches at the front of the school has also provided an important place to connect with each other and nature.

In summary, we are excited to continue our work in our goal areas and look forward to taking important next steps on our journey together at Central!
