Thursday, Oct. 19th – Photo Retake Day

Artona will be on site Thursday, Oct. 19th to take photo retakes. Any student, including grade 12's, who missed the September photo day must be photographed even if they choose not to purchase photos. Student photos are needed for the yearbook and school identification purposes. If your child had their photo taken in September, they should have viewed their photo with the QR photo code that was provided by Artona. If they have not, they can go to the Artona website (Artona.com) to view by selecting "view and order".

We kindly ask that only those students who require a retake attend photo retake day.

Student ID cards and <u>purchased</u> photo packages will be distributed to students on Monday, Oct. 16th during their period 2 class. If your child does not have a class in period 2, they can pick up from the front foyer during period 3.

Those students requesting a photo retake **MUST** bring their photo ID card to the photo retake day and give to the photographer. Students will be called down by grade starting first with all grade 9's requesting retakes, then 10's, 11 and end with 12's.

NOVEMBER NUMERACY/LITERACY ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

<u>Literacy 12 Provincial Assessment – Thursday, November 2nd</u>

All grade 12 students enrolled in English 12 this semester have been registered to write the Literacy 12 Provincial assessment on **Thursday, November 2**nd **at 8:15am.** Students will be excused from their period 1 and 2 classes and are required to be at school 15 minutes prior to the exam start time; please plan accordingly to ensure that your child arrives at 8am. Next week an email will be sent to all registered students outlining exam details, date, time, room allocations. In addition, room location lists will be posted in the front foyer a few days before he exam, please ask your child to check the list for their name. If they cannot locate their name, please have them come to the office so we can assist.

Numeracy 10/Literacy 10 Provincial Assessments – Friday, November 3rd

Any grade 11 or 12 students who have **not yet** written the Literacy 10 or Numeracy 10 assessments have been registered to write on **Friday, Nov. 3**rd **at 8:15am**. Students will be excused from their periods 1 and 2 classes, and it is their responsibility to catch up on classroom work they miss that day. Next week an email will be sent to all registered students outlining exam details, date, time, room allocations. In addition, room location lists will be posted in the front foyer a few days before the exam, please ask your child to check the list for their name. If they cannot locate their name, please have them come to the office so we can assist.

*Completion of the Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12 Provincial Assessments are required for graduation.

LANGUAGE CHALLENGE EXAMS

The Delta School District is offering language challenge exams for the 2023/2024 school year.

This exam can account for credits and meet the language 11 post-secondary entry requirements for UBC and SFU (this exam will test students on their ability to read, write and speak in this language).

Many students who have taken this challenge exams in the past are students who are in the **French Immersion Program** and wish to use this opportunity to possibly obtain a high grade for one of their grade 12 classes for the purpose of post-secondary entry requirements.

We also have students who take this exam for the sole purpose of meeting the grade 11 language requirement for post-secondary entry into UBC and SFU, but students must be **proficient in the language** if they wish to pursue this challenge exam, as these tests are rigorous and proof of how they obtained the knowledge will be required.

Students are required to provide a passport quality photograph as part of the application package.

Deadline for applications this year is Wednesday, October 25th. If students miss this deadline, they will not be able to apply this year and will have to wait until next year to reapply.
