DEADLINE SOON - EA TEEN ANIMATION PROGRAM

In this 15-week program, students learn the methods, techniques, and technologies used in animation and have the rare opportunity to learn from experienced industry professionals and hear from guest EA lecturers who provide project mentorship and skill development.
