
CAFETERIA CLOSED APRIL 16/17

WHAT THE L? DRIVER PROGRAM

This is a free opportunity for Indigenous students age 16+ to obtain their Driver's License. Only 10 spots are available, first-come, first-serve. Must be available for two sessions (**Tue, May 7 & 14, 9.30 am – 1.30 pm).** You will get to study with the support from an ICBC instructors and do practice tests.
