SCHOLARSHIP/AWARD/BURSARY INFORMATION

MOSAIC AWARDS FOR NEWCOMERS TO CANADA

Six \$5,000 awards are given to deserving recipients with financial need to support their educational and postsecondary goals. Must be new arrivals or refugees, living in Canada less than 5 years. Accepted to an educational program of either academic, professional or vocational nature. Apply by April 30.

BC TECH SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to 3 x \$2,500 are available for grade 12 graduates entering post-secondary, and additional bursaries of \$1000 are available to qualifying students who best exemplify the values of BC's tech sector. Must show passion for the technology sector, involvement in the tech community, and desire to leave a mark in the future of technology; be accepted into a BC-based post-secondary educational program beginning in 2025.

JOINT DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

If you are committed to the promotion of diversity awareness and to building strong relationships within the diverse communities around you, you may be eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship. Open to B.C. resident who will be pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited institution within the province of B.C. in the Fall of 2025. More here. Apply by May 2.

METRO VANCOUVER HOUSING BURSARIES
