PNE SUMMER JOBS

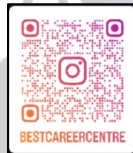

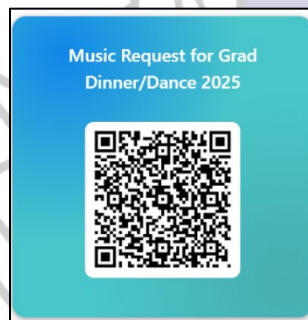
