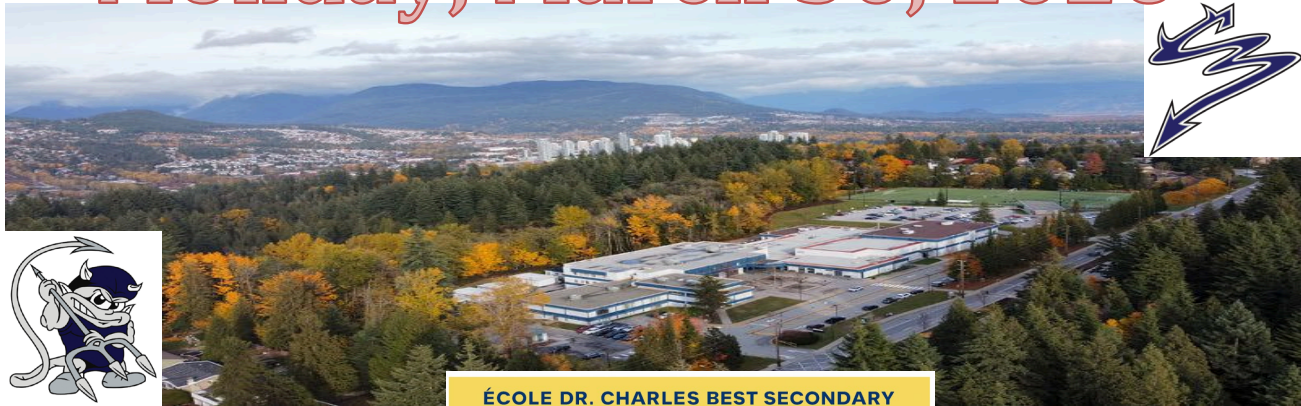

ARCHITECTURE SUMMER WORKSHOP

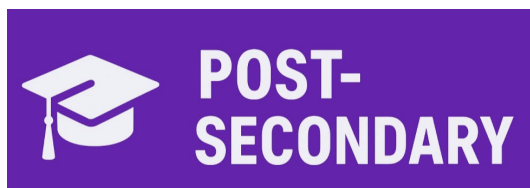
