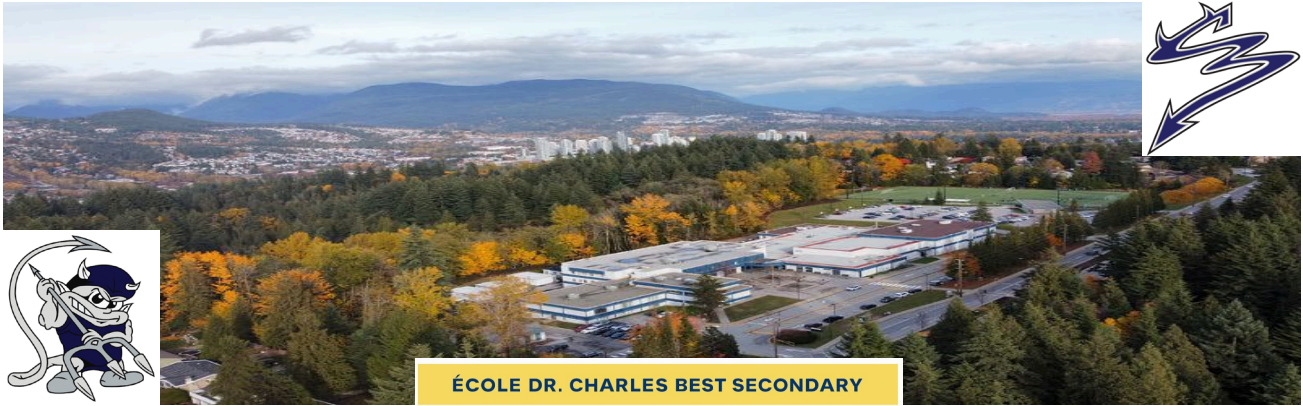

ARCHITECTURE SUMMER WORKSHOP

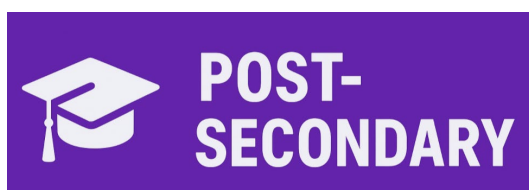

CHARLENE REAVELEY BURSARY

This \$1,000 bursary is for graduating students who have lost a parent or a sibling. Must be going into post-secondary and have demonstrated community involvement. [Apply here](#) by **April 15**.

MOSAIC AWARDS FOR NEWCOMERS TO CANADA

Six \$5,000 awards are given to deserving recipients with financial need to support their educational and post-secondary goals. Must be new arrivals or refugees, living in Canada less than 5 years. BC HOUSING BURSARIES
