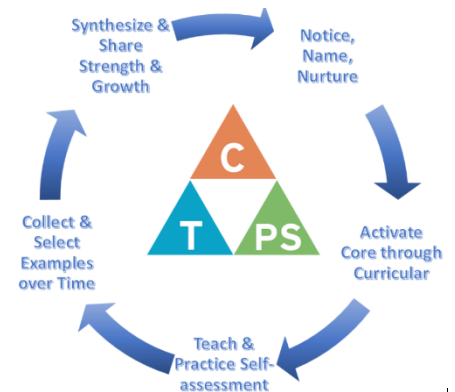


Self-Assessment of the Core Competencies


By design, the Core Competencies are foundational to the Big Ideas, Curricular Competencies, and Content of the renewed curriculum. This foundation ensures that students are always mindful of their growth in the Core Competencies through self-reflection, self-assessment, and providing evidence of growth.

The emphasis on self-reflection promotes personalization, inclusion, diversity, and student ownership of learning therefore multiple formats can be used.

This cycle illustrates building blocks that are important to address/develop in order for students to have an authentic experience with the final self-assessment of the core competencies.
