Principal's Report: Rick Dhaliwal / Rachel French

- Presentation by Brazilian Presenter...students enjoyed it. There was a residency done at a previous school to learn about Brazilian culture that could be an option if the PAC wants to support here at Citadel.
- Grade 8's went to camp...great feedback from kids and teachers, and it was a great team building activity for all.
- Open House with a great attendance, 350 hot dogs were served. They did run out unfortunately. Looking into an RSVP system may be set up next year to ensure hot dogs for all.
- Terry Fox Run...approx. \$7119 raised. The goal is \$10,000 so that Mr. Gill will shave his head. The students have until the end of the year for that goal.
- Truth and Reconciliation assembly—Mr. Goring's class did some drumming.
- Looking ahead...planning is in place for Halloween. Spirit assembly in the morning and then teachers are going to work on the activities in the afternoon that could include a dance.
- Fall Sports and clubs are underway...lots of opportunity for children.
