- Assistant Superintendent Nadine Tambellini presented information about greater parent/family supports within SD43.
- SD43 running more parent info nights re: kindergarten, Montessori, French Immersion and Mandarin programs in the district.
- Upcoming info night on late immersion (Grade 6 start for French Immersion) on Dec 2 at Monte School at 7pm.
- There will be more public speaking opportunities for elementary, middle and high school students "Miked Up" there will be a newsletter sent to schools about this interactive opportunity (will work with students on spoken word, PowerPoint presentations, public speaking, etc).
- Anti-Racism Presentation by District Principal Wendy Yu.
- Process in place to work with administrators, teachers and student at all levels to educate and support anti-racism initiatives in SD43.
- Current challenges in SD43 racial slurs (especially the N word at middle school typically because students don't understand the history of the word) she will be giving general guidelines to schools who have identified this as an issue at their schools.
- New resources coming soon at all levels of SD43.
- Important for parents to work with their children on standing up against racism/report racism and do their own research and reflect on their own lived experiences and encourage open communication.
