**Bring your own device:**

Citadel is a Bring Your Own Device school. I believe the school will be sending out information to this regard in September, so you may choose to wait for information from the school about recommended requirements before purchasing a device. If, however, you are anxious to take advantage of back to school sales, then you may consider the following:

The size of the laptop is a personal choice. If students are walking to and from school, they may prefer a smaller lighter laptop since they will have to carry it back and forth each day. The laptop should be large enough that it has a full keyboard (a number pad on the side is NOT required), it must also have an internal hard drive (no Chromebooks, please!).

The district is a PC-supported district, so there is very little support for Macbooks – they're often the most challenging to get onto the network or connect to other technology such as projectors. Students do not need an expensive “gaming” laptop. They need a sturdy and serviceable one capable of running all the Microsoft Office applications AND can hold a charge for at least half the day. Student desks do not have electrical outlets – charging during lessons is not feasible due to the limited number of wall plugs – so please make sure your child's laptop can last at least three hours before needing to charge.
