- b. COVID/Safety Updates – contract tracing in process – letter will be provided if there was an exposure – alternate letter provide for information and instruction

- c. Anti- Racism Journey begins – last June committed to anti-racism journey – Feb 1 2021 -Guest speaker coming to school – Black shirt day - Birthday of Martin Luther King - School on Quitlam first nations land – received a flag for ceremony, to be put up in school – teachers conducting a read along story for students – conversation about privilege, oppression and hope to be conducted
  - d. T-shirts – logos designed by teams – finals were chosen and put on T- Shirts – to be distributed in February
  - e. Spending allocation updates – circuit boards have been ordered - scissors and mic on its way
  - f. Wishful thinking – didn't ask for student fees this year – staff want to make it feel like Xmas – kids made gingerbread houses – proposal to PAC hoping to consider using some of the gaming funds for school wide initiatives
  - g. BYOD for 6/7 – survey sent home – starting roll out next week – school has enough devices for any student without a device – if more devices are needed, SD to support - plan to implement whole school next year
