## Principal's Report

- We were also lucky to receive a grant from the SD43 Education Foundation for \$2,000 to help pay for our Britannia Mine Field Trip.
- December/January Highlights:
  - To support our school Literacy Goal, we have been having “Drop Everything and Read” or DEAR sessions with students where they sit and enjoy a book of their choice for an hour.
  - Students have been working on indigenous animal projects in their classes where they are learning about animals that are important to British Columbia.
  - Teachers received training on the “4<sup>th</sup> R” which focuses on students working on positive and healthy relationships and connections. They are going to be using some of these lessons (for example on peer to peer conflict) to support our school goal on interconnectedness.
  - January also brings important transition events for our Grade 8 students. Both Centennial and Charles Best Secondary hosted course-planning sessions and parent information meetings throughout the month. Parent nights are happening tonight.
  - Genius Hour Projects – gearing up for the February Thursdays. Students are feeling a lot of agencies in their learning as they pick their topics.
  - Mountain Riders – Ski and Snowboard has had some fantastic weather up the mountain already. Students have enjoyed 2 fantastic afternoons and evenings so far.
- Skating Field trips are happening soon.

- All students will go to Britannia Mine in February for a curricular field trip focusing on themes such as sustainability, adaptability, and the impact of civilizations. Hands-on, experiential sessions will be enjoyed by students.
- Learning Updates were posted in December. Student Reflection Interim reports go home by February 10<sup>th</sup> with optional 3-way conferences on February 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Next Learning Update (Report Cards) go home right before Spring Break.
- We are looking at a band concert later in February – more details to follow.
- Leadership lunch fundraisers are going to continue to happen and support school programs. We are going to do another hamper for families closer to Spring Break.

## **The Nest Portable**

- Discussion held regarding *The Nest Portable*, a culturally safe and inclusive space.
- Purpose: a place to learn about Indigenous traditions and culture.
- Emphasis on a multi-sensory experience (sight, sound, smell, etc.).
