Prohibited Uses

- 3. Extra lighting, curtains, props, etc. for in-school theatre/drama classes.
- 4. Purchasing items that are the responsibility of the school or school district (e.g. audiovisual equipment, digital news reader boards, library books, outdoor classrooms, personal protective equipment, etc.). ** Video Equipment?
