When report cards are published, they are accessible in the "Published Reports" field as PDF's which can be viewed, printed and saved. We strongly recommend saving a copy of the PDF for future reference. Access to the portal can be found **HERE**. A few things to remember: Download and save and/or print the report card for your records before July 31 as they will be permanently deleted from the portal thereafter. For security purposes, your password will need to be reset every 90 days. It is a good idea to record your password in a safe location

GRADE 6 IMMUNIZATIONS

Routine Immunizations with Fraser Health for Como Lake Grade 6 students is scheduled for:

#1: Friday, January 9th, 2026 #2: Thursday, May 7th, 2026

Immunization consent forms from Fraser Health will be distributed to grade 6 students in the upcoming days. It is important for students and their parent(s)/guardian(s) to review the consent package and talk about consent for routine child immunization, together.

Once completed, please place the consent form in the sealed envelope labelled "School Nurse" and return it to the school office. A Fraser Health Nurse will be collecting them as they prepare for the immunization date at Como Lake in January.

International students staying for 6 months or greater will be offered immunizations at the school.

As in previous years, COVID-19 vaccines will not be provided as part of the school based immunization program.

WINTER WEATHER AHEAD!

Schools are not routinely closed due to snow or other inclement weather conditions. All schools in School District43 (Coquitlam) will remain OPEN, if at all possible, during winter weather, including snowfall. However, on occasion, a district-wide or partial-district closure is required due to extreme Partial-district weather. closures affectina individual schools may occur due to the very different geography within our school district. If there is a partial-district closure, affected schools will be identified. The decision on schools remaining open or needing to be closed, because of extreme weather, occurs before 6:30a.m. so that families can plan and make alternate arrangements.

Any district-wide or partial-district closure will be decided and communicated by 6:30a.m. via the School District 43 website www.sd43.bc.ca and CKNW AM980 radio, CKWX 1130 radio and CBC(690) radio. Extreme weather can also impact transit. Transit schedules may face significant changes or cancellations due to the weather conditions. 

The Student Verification Form will be found under the "Published Reports" section of the MyEd Family portal.


Login TO MYED BC Portal

Access to the portal can be found <u>HERE</u>. It is best practice to go to our school website and click on "MyEdBC Family Portal" under "Quick Links." Avoid using google to search for MyEd BC because it often takes you to a different link and it won't work properly!

Your MyEd BC Login is 43-youremailaddress. Please note that every three months, the system requires you to create a new password. This is for security purposes and we suggest you have your passwords written down somewhere safe to refer to! If you can't remember your password, you can request for a Password Reset when logging in (see below).



You can reset the password for MyEd Portal by clicking on "I forgot my password"
