#### **A fond farewell**

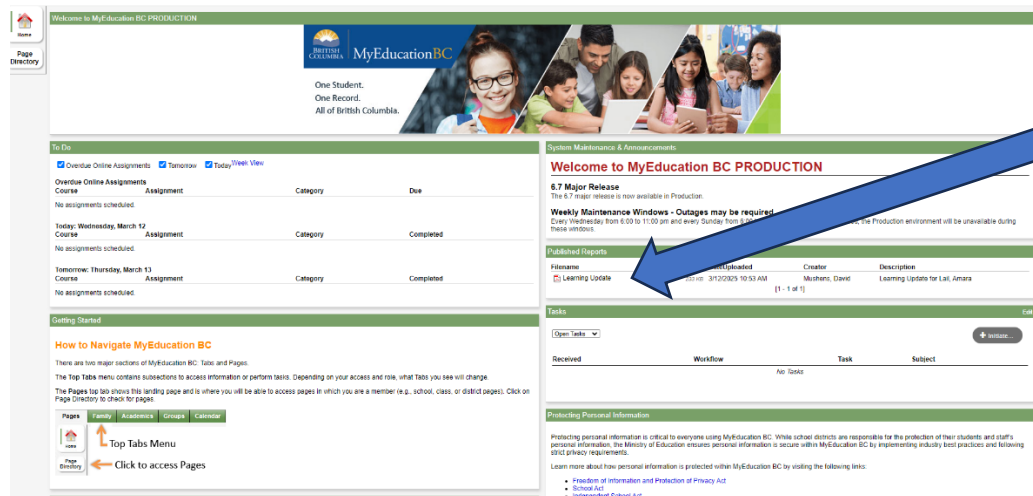
